### REGULATIONS

1. Exhibitors must deliver their exhibits to the Homecrafts Pavilion between 2 pm and 7 pm on Thursday 31st October or 8am & 10am on Friday 1st November 2019 via Gate 1 - Parking in Members Car Park only.
2. All exhibitors shall place or attach entry card to the proper exhibit before the judges enter upon their duties.
3. No person, other than the Judges and Stewards shall be permitted to be present in any section while judging is proceeding. Should any breach of this rule occur judging must cease until the rule is complied with.
4. All exhibits must be grown by the exhibitor and have been in his or her possession at least two months prior to the Show, except in Floral Art and Novice.
5. All exhibits shall be considered the property of the Show until after the close of the Show (5.30pm Sunday), but the Society will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any exhibit. No exhibit may be removed until after the close of the Show, when exhibitors shall be in attendance to take charge of their exhibits.
6. Wiring is allowed except where otherwise stated.
7. A bowl is a circular vessel the diameter of which is greater than its height.
8. No artificial flowers unless specified.
